Check all those boxes for *BoccaLupo*, Bruce Logue's new low-key Italian spot that'll bring out your "let's get to know each other over black spaghetti and prosecco-modified Negronis" side, soft-opening tonight in Inman Park.

This could be a restaurant. Or it could be the quaint home of an Italian grandmother who's having everyone in the neighborhood over for dinner. We're not sure. But there's a framed Mama Leone's menu from the '60s, *candlelit two-tops everywhere* and the occasional Sinatra song piping through the place.



Call in a reservation for two. Request a table on the open-air patio. Allow your conversation to be inspired by some aptly named *In Good Company* cocktails (rye whiskey, chocolate bitters, port wine foam). Then someone will drop off some Southern fried-chicken cacciatore. You'll forget what you were talking about. This place is good like that.

For now, it's just regular dinner hours. But soon, they'll start up a late-night weekend menu. Including something that's equivalent to the Italian version of ramen noodles.

And at 12:30am, that's equivalent to fantastic.
